text	Tallinn Law School of Tallinn University of Technology (TUT) is participating in a prestigious international EU TEMPUS funded project. Under this project 3 EU universities (Alicante, Maastricht and TUT) are cooperating with around 10 Arab state universities (in Egypt, Jordan and Palestine) to help them to develop a joint Master's program in Law and Technology. 	This month, the Bench marking Study Visit took place in Tallinn from 16 - 18 November. 25 senior delegates from Arab universities, National IP Offices, National R&D Offices, etc of Egypt, Jordan and Palestine visited TUT to discuss law and technology issues.
	These senior Arab state representatives received presentations by Professor Tanel Kerikmae and Professor Katrin Nyman-Metcalf on the various intellectual property law and technology law programs conducted in our university. They also attended an interesting discussion on the start-up culture in Estonia which was presented by Eesti Arengufond specialists. Later a presentation on e-Estonia was made by the eGovernance Academy specialists. Finally the participants went on a guided tour of Mektory where they studied the vibrant and dynamic start up culture and state support system for SMEs in Estonia.
	Further cooperation possibilities between TUT and the universities of various Arab states in the fields of Intellectual Property Rights, Information and Communication Technology, eGovernance, etc were also discussed.
